

NORTH CAROLINA OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Awards up to \$4,200



The NC Opportunity Scholarship expands School Choice in North Carolina by providing education scholarship grants for eligible children who choose to attend a private school. All scholarship students will qualify to receive a grant of up to \$4,200.

Who Qualifies?

For the 2019 school year and future years, students will be eligible if they have not received a high school diploma and meet at least one of the following requirements:

- Was a full-time student assigned to and attending a NC public school in the previous semester
- Received an Opportunity Scholarship in the previous year
- Is entering Kindergarten or 1st grade
- Is a child in foster care or was adopted within the last year
- Has a parent on full-time active duty with the military
